

FNB MAPUTO 10K VIRTUAL RACE

PARTICIPATION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Participants registered in the FNB Maputo 10K Virtual Race undertake to respect the terms and conditions below.

These Terms and Conditions ("the Terms and Conditions") govern the registration and participation of the participant in the event.

1. INFORMATION ABOUT THE EVENT

1.1. By registering for the Event, you agree that you are bound and that your participation is subject to these Terms and Conditions.

1.2. The Event will take place between 5:00 am and 7:00 pm on November 29, 2020. You must participate using the Run Your City Tracking App (the "application") on your mobile phone to track your progress according to the instructions issued by the organization event. The application can be downloaded from the App Store (iOS) or Google Play Store (Android).

1.3. Participation in the Event can be done from anywhere in the world.

1.4. The Event will start on November 29, 2020 at the same time for all participants, worldwide. All registrants will be notified of any changes to the event date and time.

1.5. The participants' progress will be monitored through the application during the Event and will be available to the general public in real time at the event or through the official website <https://maputo10k.com/> ("Maputo10K Website"). After the challenge, your name and race time will appear in the list of results in the application and on the Maputo 10K website.

1.6. In order to record results, each participant must complete their course within the stipulated time, starting at 5:00 am and ending at 7:00 pm. Participants who try to participate outside the set time will not be considered. The time will be calculated between the start of the race, registered in the application, and the completion of the course (10 KM).

2. ADMISSION AND REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

2.1. Registration for the Event must be done online via the official website of the Maputo 10K event, which will redirect you to the Entry Ninja platform where you will be asked to complete your registration and payment.

2.2. All registrants must pick up the Race Kits at the place defined for that purpose. The collection of the race kit is the participant's responsibility.

2.3. You must download the application on your mobile phone and follow the steps described, ensuring that your subscription is associated with your profile. Your progress at the Event will be monitored in real time by the application.

2.4. The registration of the participation in the Event implies that the participants have a mobile phone whose GPS is functional or the possibility of manual registration at the end of the tour. .

2.5. Registration for the FNB Maputo 10K virtual race ends on November 28, 2020. Event organizers reserve the right to accept or reject registrations for the event.

2.6. The distribution of Racing Kits will be limited to the first 1,500 registered entries. Above this number of registrations, the Race Kit is not guaranteed.

2.7. Communications related to the event will be released via email or SMS. It is the responsibility of the subscribers to ensure the correct supply of their data and contacts. Registrants can contact the organizers for this purpose through entries@maputo10k.com.

3. RUNNER NUMBER

3.1. Each Race Kit will include a runner number, which is associated with the name of the respective participant and his official result.

3.2. The Racing Kits must be picked up at the location indicated for this purpose. Participants must put their official runner number on the front of the T-Shirt during the Event.

4. PAYMENT CONDITIONS

4.1. The registration fee for the Event is indicated on the Maputo 10K website. When entering the Event on the Maputo 10K Website, you will be redirected to the Entry Ninja Platform, where you must register.

4.2. The use of the Entry Ninja platform is subject to the standard Entry Ninja terms and conditions available at: <https://www.entryninja.com/terms-and-conditions>

4.3. The Organization reserves the right to change, at any time, the registration fee for the Event, without prior notice.

4.4. Under no circumstances will credit card numbers or payment details be kept by the Event Organizer or its service provider (Entry Ninja).

5. RISKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE EVENT

5.1. The registrant agrees to participate in the Event at his own risk and recognizes that the Event organizer cannot be held responsible for potential risks, including foreseeable risks. Registrants must strictly comply with all applicable rules, directives and instructions by the Event Organization.

5.2. The registrant understands and recognizes that there are risks and dangers associated with events of this nature and that the possible effects of these risks may vary, so you commit to give up participating if:

5.2.1. feel or observe any type of anomaly that, in some way, leads you to fear that it is not safe to continue participating in the Event

5.2.2. feel unable or unable to continue participating in the Event safely.

6. CHILDREN'S PARTICIPATION IN EVENTS

6.1. By consenting to the participation of the minor in his care, the guardian agrees that he will not be liable to Stillwater Sports Proprietary Limited, its directors, affiliates, shareholders, sponsors, partners, employees, volunteers and / or any third party service providers. for losses or damages that the minor may suffer as a result of his participation in the Event.

6.2. By registering for the Event, on behalf of a minor, you confirm that you are duly authorized by law to act and legally bind the minor. In addition, the registrant hereby agrees to exempt Stillwater Sports Proprietary Limited, its directors, affiliates, shareholders, sponsors, partners, employees, volunteers and / or any third party service providers from any claims resulting from the absence of such legal authority.

7. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY

7.1. The following liability limitation and indemnity provisions apply to all Event participants in favor of Stillwater Sports Proprietary Limited, its directors, affiliates, shareholders, sponsors, partners, employees, volunteers and / or any third party service providers, whether whatever the source of such responsibility, and in whatever form it has integrated the Event.

7.2. The registrant accepts and agrees that Stillwater Sports Proprietary Limited, its affiliates, shareholders, sponsors, partners, volunteer workers and / or any third party service providers attending the Event (hereinafter referred to as "Parties") do not accept any responsibility or obligation for any claim resulting from death, injury, loss and / or damage to people or property caused as a result of your participation in the Event. Thus, the registrant hereby exempts the Parties, to the extent possible by law, against any claims resulting from their participation regardless of their nature or resulting from any loss, injury, illness, death or damage of any nature and whatever the cause direct or indirect resulting from any act or omission, negligent acts or omissions of the Parties, including

claims for loss resulting from damage suffered, loss of profits or any claim by any of their dependents resulting from events related to, or resulting from their participation in the Event .

7.3. The registrant agrees that the limitation of liability recorded herein applies to you, your assets, your dependents and any successors.

8. COVID-19

8.1. The registrant must take the necessary precautions to protect his safety and that of others, especially with regard to the risk of spreading COVID-19, during his participation in the Event, for which he is responsible.

8.2. You agree and undertake, during your participation in the Event, to comply with all relevant laws, regulations and guidelines issued by the national and / or local government and by the local and national health authorities and that are in force on the day of the Event regarding COVID -19.

8.3. No physical route or route will be demarcated or blocked for the Event, participants must create their own route, and must not follow any "official" route or routes traveled in previous editions of the FNB Maputo 10K race.

8.4. The registrant must keep updated on the symptoms of COVID-19 (dry cough, fever and potential breathing difficulties), as well as the risks of transmission.

9. REFUND POLICY

9.1. All registration fees for the Event are non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances, including, for example, canceling the Event for any reason or withdrawing your participation in the Event or changing the date, nature or format of the Event.

9.2. The registrant acknowledges that the Event may be canceled or changed due to government directives, bad weather or any other factors that could be considered a threat to the participants' security, as determined by the Event organizer, exclusively at its discretion.

9.3. The event organizers reserve the right to reject or cancel any registration for the Event, in these circumstances, the registration fee will be refunded.

10. PERSONAL DATA

10.1. Registration for the Event implies the registration of the registrants' data, namely: information that directly or indirectly identifies you: name, age, race, sex, e-mail address, location and / or language ("Personal Data"). The processing of the participants' personal data is a conditioning the use of the Application, therefore, registration for the Event cannot be made without such processing.

10.2. The data provided at the time of registration must be true and correct in all aspects, failure to comply with this condition constitutes a violation of these Terms and Conditions. If registration is done on behalf of another person, you must ensure the proper authorization for this purpose.

10.3. In these circumstances, the registrant expressly accepts that his Personal Data is collected, used and shared for the purpose of his participation in the Event, and as recommended in the privacy policy available at <https://www.entryninja.com/privacy-policy>.

10.4. In addition, you expressly acknowledge and agree that:

10.4.1. Following your registration at the Event, the Event organizer may contact you periodically (via email, short message service and / or telephone calls) in order to communicate information related to the Event;

10.4.2. The event organizer reserves the right to mention your name and other information in the media (photographs, video tapes, radio broadcasts and television broadcasts) in which it may eventually appear;

10.4.3. The Event organizer may process your personal information (i) internally and / or in one of its branches or any other legal entity, joint venture and / or partnership wherever it is located or operates, provides services or conducts business similar to those of the organizer the Event; and / or (ii) through any third party with whom the Event organizer concludes a service provision contract for the purpose of delivering the Event and the products and services that are part of it; and

10.4.4. If you choose to participate, you agree that your Personal Data will remain confidential, but you consent to sharing it with the parties involved in organizing the Event for the purpose of sending material related to the Event and promoting activities related to the Event (material of marketing, advertising material, newsletters or any other information material related to the Event organizer, its business and / or any other sporting events in which the Event organizer considers it may be interested).

10.5. Your Personal Data will be processed in accordance with the applicable law, the present terms and conditions and the requirements directly applicable to the provision of the Event services. Your Personal Data will only be processed in a manner consistent with the operational requirements of the Event and the Maputo 10K Website and only when necessary.

10.6. Your Personal Data will be erased and / or destroyed upon receipt of your written instruction, for this purpose, and / or when they are no longer necessary for the purposes for which they were initially collected or subsequently processed.

10.7. The event organizer can retain anonymous information from deleted profiles to comply with the law, prevent fraud, resolve disputes, resolve conflicts and enforce terms. Any information retained will be treated in accordance with the organizer's Privacy Policy.

10.8. Adequate and reasonable technical and organizational measures will be taken as required by applicable law, in order to protect information submitted or collected by the event organizer and prevent loss, misuse, unauthorized access, disclosure, alteration or destruction.

10.9. The transmission of your personal data over the Internet is not without risks and the Customer acknowledges and agrees that no guarantee of security of information transmission is provided. Your personal data will be provided at your own risk.

11. MORE EVENT RULES

Depending on the location chosen, additional rules may apply to the Event. These concern the rules of local sports federations or bodies, national or local traffic regulations, local government rules and any rules that apply to a facility or area that you can use during your participation in the Event. The registrant must agree to comply with any and all additional rules of this nature.

You also agree to familiarize yourself with all these additional rules and exempt the event organizer from any damage suffered as a result of your non-compliance with them.

12. PENALTY FOR BREACH OF RULES

12.1. The registrant declares that he was not suspended or prohibited from participating in the FNB Maputo 10K race or in associated events, otherwise he will respect the prohibition if it applies to you, for any reason.

12.2. Violation of the terms of this document implies the application of a penalty by the organization of the Event, including the prohibition of future participation in the Event or related events.

12.3. Hereby, the registrant irrevocably consents that his name and / or corridor number is and publicly displayed and published (including on the Internet) in the event of being disqualified from the Event or receiving another sanction resulting from the violation of these terms and conditions or the rules of the Event.

13. GENERAL

13.1. The Event organizer reserves the right to change the date and / or time of the Event, if deemed necessary.

13.2. By participating in the Event, you guarantee that you are in good health, physically fit and sufficiently prepared to do so.

13.3. If one or more of these terms is found to be inapplicable, that term will be considered independent of the rest of the terms and the remaining terms will remain in all other respects in full force and effect.

13.4. The registrant confirms that he understands the importance and meaning of these terms and conditions and that, by agreeing to them, he waives substantial legal rights (in his own name and in the name of those in his care). In addition, it recognizes that it was free to obtain legal advice and / or other independent advice as to the nature and effect of all the provisions of this Regulation, and that it accepted that legal advice and / or other independent advice, or waived it.

13.5. It is mandatory to keep as far as possible within the shoulder of the left lane of the road, taking into account the circumstances and conditions.

13.6. When participating in the Event, you are obliged to adhere to local traffic laws and regulations and road codes. Traffic officers and / or police officers must obey at all times. If a traffic police officer or police officer instructs you to stop, you should do so immediately.

13.7. You must complete the race with your own effort and you will not be able to receive any assistance for this purpose.
